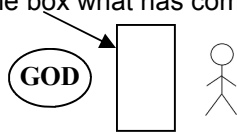

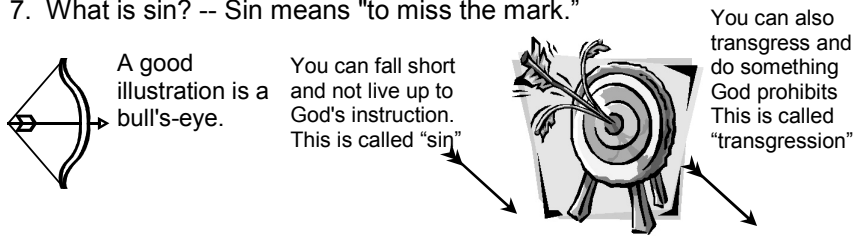

6. **Romans 3:23** Who has sinned according to this verse?

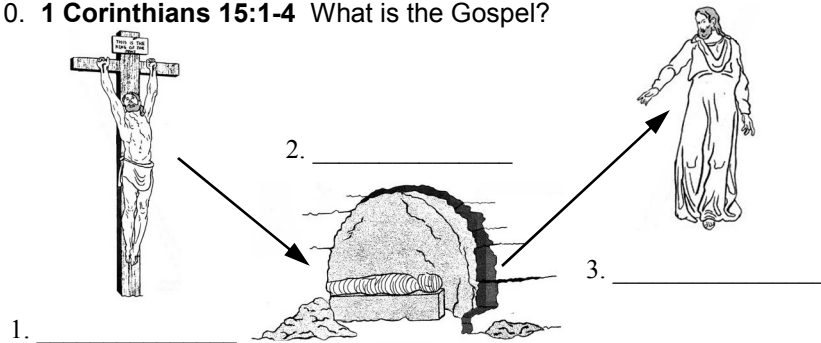
7. What is sin? -- Sin means "to miss the mark."
